

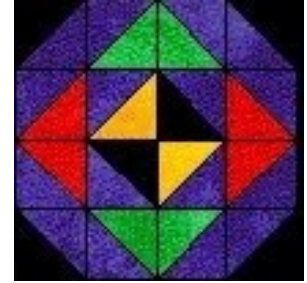

## “Mixed Up Star”

### Individual Block instructions

Mixed Up Star (12" finished block, Make one block)	
(A) Black	Cut 3 squares 3 7/8", cut once diagonally
(B) Green	Cut 2 squares 3 7/8", cut once diagonally
(C) Red	Cut 2 squares 3 7/8", cut once diagonally
(D) Yellow	Cut 1 square 3 7/8", cut once diagonally
(F) Blue	Cut 8 squares 3 7/8", cut once diagonally



### Assembly & Block Construction of the Mixed Up Star

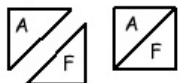

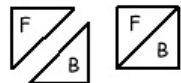

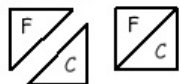
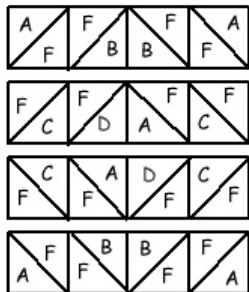

Block Construction



1. Sew (1) one (F) Blue HST to (1) one (A) Black HST. See diagram 1 for placement.
2. Measurement check – should measure 4½" square.
3. Repeat Step 1 five (5) more times for a total of six (6) units.
4. Sew (1) one (F) Blue HST to (1) one (B) Green HST. See diagram 2 for placement.
5. Measurement check – should measure 4½" square.
6. Repeat Step 4 three (3) more times for a total of four (4) units.
7. Sew (1) one (F) Blue HST to (1) one (C) Red HST. See diagram 3 for placement.
8. Measurement check – should measure 4½" square.
9. Repeat Step 7 three (3) more times for a total of four (4) units.
10. Sew (1) one (F) Blue HST to (1) one (D) Yellow HST. See diagram 4 for placement.
11. Repeat Step 10 one (1) more time for a total of two (2) units.
12. Measurement check – should measure 4½" square.

#### Assembly

- Sew the rows together as shown in Block Diagram.
- Press and YOUR block is complete.

Block should measure 12½" square.
