Individual Block instructions

Star Burst (12" finished block, Make one block)		
(A) Black	Cut 4 squares 3½" Cut 1 square 7 1/4", cut twice diagonally	
(C) Red	Cut 4 squares 3 7/8", cut once diagonally	
(F) Blue	Cut 1 square 6½"	
<i>Assembly & Block Construction of the Star Burst</i>		
1.	Sew one (C) Red HST to one (A) Black QST. See diagram 1 for placement.	Diagram 1 
2.	Referring to diagram 2 sew one (C) Red HST to the unit from step 1. Flying geese unit made. Measurement check – should measure 3½" x 6½"	Diagram 2 Flying Geese Unit 
3.	Repeat steps 1 and 2 three more times for a total of 4 flying geese units.	Diagram 3 
4.	Sew one (A) Black 3½" squares to opposite sides of one Flying Geese unit. See diagram 3 for placement. Measurement check – should measure 3½" x 12½"	Diagram 4 
5.	Repeat step 4 one more time for a total of two row 1's. Press and label Row 1 and Row 3.	Block Construction 
6.	Sew one Flying Geese unit to opposite sides of one (F) Blue 6½" square. See diagram 4 for placement. Press and label row 2. Measurement check – should measure 6½" x 12½"	
7.	Sew rows together as show in row construction diagram to complete the block.	
8.	Press and check to see if your block measures 12½" square.
